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Los Angeles – Las Vegas – San Francisco

8 Days Tour

- Day 1: Home – Los Angeles
- Day 2: Los Angeles - Las Vegas
 - Departure from Los Angeles in the morning, along with San Bernardino Mountains and enter Mojave Desert, the largest continental desert in North America. The boundless land is decorated by bizarre-shaped Joshua trees and yucca plants. You will make a brief stop at Tanger. And then head to Las Vegas - “the entertainment capital of the world”. We enjoy lunch there by your own. You may take an optional night tour to explore the prosperity of night life in Las Vegas, enjoy all the spectacles and fantasies on the strip! The tour guide will lead you to explore the World’s largest hotel Palazzo Venetian Mega Centre, neon-light show on Fremont Street, Music Fountain at Bellagio and the volcano show at Mirage. Stay overnight in Las Vegas.
- Day 3: Las Vegas - Hoover Dam - Grand Canyon West/South Rim- Las Vegas
 - Drive to Hoover Dam in the morning, sightsee this largest and tallest concrete structure of its time. Visit the dam and overlook North America’s largest artificial lake - Lake Mead. Then, travel to one of the most famous 7 natural wonders in the world - the Grand Canyon! **You can choose to go to West Rim or South Rim, admission fee is mandatory: West Rim (Skywalk):** Over eons, the Colorado River and erosion have sculpted this amazing landscape. Grand Canyon west rim belongs to Indian Reservation. The group will take the designated park shuttle to enter the canyon. Upon arriving in the terminal, you may take the helicopter ride and sightseeing boat tour (Optional), in order to feel the canyon and Colorado River from different perspective and explore the true beauty of the Grand Canyon. Afterwards, you may take the park shuttle to the next sightseeing spots, Eagle Point and Guano Point. At Eagle Point, you may take an optional visit to the "Skywalk", which is the new gigantic construction built on the very edge of the Grand Canyon West Rim. The group will return to Las Vegas in the evening. You may watch the world’s renowned show at your own cost (optional). ***The west canyon entrance fee (lunch included) increases from \$80 to \$90(Start from 1st April 2016). Customers who participate in this trip should pay the entrance fee.**

South Rim: Here is the world's most vivid erosion model, which is why the Grand Canyon has not only become a textbook for the geologist and paleontologist, but also made the millions of tourists each year filled with emotion when they face the masterpiece of creator. You may watch the IMAX movie of the history of Grand Canyon at the entrance at your own cost. Then, go to the largest view point near visitor center - Mather Point. If God is the creator of the Grand Canyon, Colorado River is an artist who has carved the Grand Canyon. Despite the passion in summer and the cold in winter, the river and valley's history of romance has been going on for six hundred million years long. Sunshine and clouds are always alternating controls over the canyon, adding a dash of style to the magnificent scenic picture. The group will return to Las Vegas in the evening. You may watch the world's renowned show at your own cost (optional). ***Customers who participate in this trip should pay the south canyon entrance fee \$50(bus fee included).**

- Day 4: Chocolate Factory - Ethel M Chocolate Factory/Botanical Cactus Gardens - Outlets Center - Los Angeles
 - In the morning, visit Ethel M Chocolate Factory and Botanical Cactus Gardens outside of The Strip. You can see chocolates being made, sample gourmet treats and meander through the maze of paths at the Botanical Cactus Gardens at no charge. Be sure to sample a piece of fresh made chocolate! After having lunch in Las Vegas, the group heads back to Los Angeles. Stop by Outlets Center for short rest before continuing to Los Angeles. Arrive in Los Angeles in the evening.

- Day 6: Los Angeles - Santa Barbara - San Francisco
 - **Line A: Los Angeles- Santa Barbara- Solvang- Silicon Valley-San Francisco**
 - Depart from Los Angeles this morning and drive to Santa Barbara, the 'America's Riviera'! Enjoy beautiful scenery of the Pacific Coast along the way. The new Mediterranean and Old Spanish style Architectures are surrounded by flowers and lawns; this little Central California Coastal City is one of the most popular vacation destinations. Then drive to Solvang, Danish for 'Sunny Field'! The cozy little town is dominated by Danish style architectures and known for warm sunshine year round. Drive to Silicon Valley next, the ICON of America's High Tech Sectors. Arrive in Bay Area (Greater San Francisco) in the evening and stay overnight.
 - **Line B: Los Angeles- 17 Mile Drive – San Francisco**
 - Depart from Los Angeles this morning and drive to Santa Barbara, the 'America's Riviera'! Enjoy beautiful scenery of the Pacific Coast along the way. The new Mediterranean and Old Spanish style Architectures are surrounded by flowers and lawns; this little Central California Coastal City is one of the most popular vacation destinations. Head to the picturesque Monterey Peninsula afterwards, gentle sea breezes, meandering coast, surging waves, bizarre rocks, adorable

seals and sea lions rest on the beach; world's first-class golf courses (stop 30 minutes for sightseeing, 5 Grand Slam have been held here) stretch beyond shiny multi-million dollar mansions.. Scenery of 17 Miles (Admission included) is truly breathtaking. World's famous California Highway 1 (drive on); Symbol of 17-Mile Drive "Lone Cypress"(Stop for Sightseeing); the stunning view of 17 Miles... ensuing surprises come one after another and simply indulge yourself in this poetic wonderland. Arrive in Bay Area (Greater San Francisco) in the evening and stay overnight.

➤ Day 7: San Francisco City Tour

- **Line A: UC Berkeley—Cable Car—San Francisco**

- We visit the campus of UC Berkeley in the morning. Faculty, alumni and staffs of Berkeley have won 72 Nobel Prizes. From the nostalgic campus, Golden Gate Bridge and Golden Gate Straight can both be seen! UC Berkeley is one of world's top universities. Drive to San Francisco afterwards, home to over 50 rolling hills and surrounded by water on 3 sides. We take a Cable Car ride (Ticket Mandatory), known as "the only mobile monument of America", and enjoy the city view. Then explore the landmark of SF, the Golden Gate Bridge, the delicious seafood and a Sightseeing Boat Tour (optional) departs from Fisherman's Wharf. Visit the only building remaining from 1915 world's exposition, the Palace of Fine Arts. The romantic and compacted Victorian Houses and fresh sea breeze lure millions of visitors every year!

- **Line B: Stanford University—San Francisco**

- We visit the campus of Stanford in the morning. It covers 35 square kilometers, the second largest and the most beautiful campus in America. Alumni of Stanford have founded some of the largest high-tech companies: Google, Yahoo, Cisco, and Hewlett Packard. Drive to San Francisco afterwards, home to over 50 rolling hills and surrounded by water on 3 sides. We explore the landmark of SF, the Golden Gate Bridge, the delicious seafood and a Sightseeing Boat Tour (optional) departs from Fisherman's Wharf. Visit the only building remaining from 1915 world's exposition, "the Palace of Fine Arts", and the famous Lombard Street. The romantic and compacted Victorian Houses and fresh sea breeze lure millions of visitors every year! Stay Overnight in Central California, Modesto.

➤ Day 8: San Francisco - Los Angeles

- **Line A: Roaring Camp Redwood Forest Train-17Miles-Monterey Aquarium-Los Angeles**

- This morning we are headed to Roaring Camp, a beautiful small village located in California Coastal Mountains. 'Wooh'... The steam train may sound farfetched today, but brings back sweet memories. As the whole world is adapted to maglev trains and highways, we take a lovely and scenic ride on a nostalgic steam train today! Departs from authentic western village, winds through redwood forests; it's truly a memorable experience! Head to the picturesque Monterey Peninsula afterwards, gentle sea breezes, meandering coast, surging waves, bizarre rocks, adorable seals and sea lions rest on the beach; world's first-class golf courses (stop 30 minutes for sightseeing, 5 Grand Slam have been held here) stretch beyond shiny multi-million dollar mansions.. Scenery of 17 Miles (Admission included) is truly breathtaking. World's famous California Highway 1 (drive on); honeymooner's Mecca - Lovers Point(drive by); the stunning view of 17 Miles... ensuing surprises come one after another and simply indulge yourself in this

poetic wonderland. To all Monterey's visitors, the world's famous Aquarium is a must-see. Over 600 species of marine life including colorful fishes and deep-sea monsters, call the Aquarium home, seagulls flying high above! Return to Los Angeles in the evening and finish our joyful 3-day San Francisco and 17-Mile trip.

- **Line B: Yosemite National Park - Los Angeles**

- Depart from the hotel this morning, the Sierra Nevada Mountains stretch beyond, it's where our destination sets today, the Yosemite National Park. Towering granite rocks, magnificent waterfalls and tranquil valley, making Yosemite a fairyland from every angle you look. Giant trees, mountains and sparkling streams and lakes, glaciers-carved canyons, call Yosemite home. El Capitan - world's largest granite monolith, tallest waterfall in North America "Yosemite Falls", Half Dome, and Bridal Veil Waterfall... wonders come one after another! Take a walk in the woods and the fresh forest air smells like champagne! After lunch, we travel across Central Valley of California, where over half of the fruits, nuts, and vegetables grown in country are produced very year. In the evening we return to Los Angeles, and finish our pleasant 3-day San Francisco-Yosemite-17-Mile Drive tour.
